

SITUATION

When it came to redesigning the Westchester Family YMCA in Los Angeles, CA, West Edge Architects knew that they were going to be initiating both a social and physical change in the community space. OBJECTIVE

To achieve a welcoming effect in the space, the design team used wooden accents as one of their primary design mediums. However, the team quickly realized that they needed a replacement for real wood planks—without sacrificing quality or their vision of giving off a real wood impression.
